They run the Enterprise Resource Center in San Rafael—a free, peer-led space where people can find community, encouragement, and resources around mental health and recovery.

Open every day from 10 a.m.–4 p.m., the center offers groups for everything from art and writing to meditation, trauma support, and recovery tools. It's a safe, inclusive spot where everyone's voice matters.

MHAM also runs a Warmline—a friendly, confidential phone line you can call daily from 9 a.m.–9 p.m. if you need someone to listen, offer support, or simply be there on the other end.
